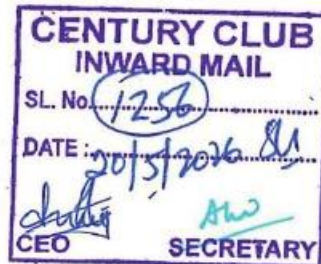

Dear Sir,

In a spirit of constructive cooperation for the welfare and smooth functioning of our premier Club, we hereby submit a formal requisition to convene a Special General Meeting (SGM) of the General Body. Please find the enclosed original requisition dated 17/05/2026 signed by more than **175** members of the club.

This requisition stands fully compliant with the criteria set forth under **Rule 23.3 and Rule 23.4 of the Club Bylaws** and contains a clear statement of the specific business to be transacted.

To assist the office in processing this request smoothly, we place the following informative points on record:

- 1 Fulfillment of the January 4th Mandate:** This requisition is brought forward to complete the business initiated by the General Body on January 4, 2026, as documented in the SGM Verbatim Minutes. We note and welcome the administration's official communication to members dated May 16, 2026 (Ref: CC/207/2026), confirming that a Special General Meeting is the prescribed path under Club Rules to address the final Special Audit Committee (SAC) Report delivered on May 9, 2026. *To ensure total transparency and fair disclosure, hosting this SGM provides the proper platform for the general membership to collectively discuss the SAC report along with the Executive Committee's planned rejoinder (reply to response), enabling all matters to be resolved in a single, unified session and make necessary judgement by the members of the SGM.*
- 2 Justification for a Dedicated Session:** In express alignment with the official timeline and notice issued by the Club administration to all members on May 16, 2026, the Executive Committee is requested to schedule this SGM on a suitable weekend prior to the upcoming June 27th AGM and election cycle, *thereby ensuring that the general membership can exercise their voting franchise with complete transparency and clarity.* Reviewing a completed financial report requires focused, calm deliberation by

the members. *Holding it on a separate day ensures that we do not overload the heavily packed schedule of the AGM morning, allowing both meetings to proceed in perfect harmony, clarity, and administrative order.*

3 Fiduciary Continuity and Smooth Transition: Because the report examines the club's accounts and capital projects up to December 31, 2025, the current administration uniquely holds the necessary background knowledge and insights to address any routine floor queries or provide clarifications. *Resolving this matter under your watch ensures an orderly conclusion to past files and a clean transition, sparing the incoming committee from inheriting unreviewed historical records.* This also ensures our ongoing capital projects move forward transparently in the larger interest of the club.



REQUISITION TO CONVENE A SPECIAL GENERAL MEETING (SGM)

SUBJECT: Requisition to Convene a Special General Meeting (SGM) under Rule 23.3 and Rule 23.4 of the Club Bylaws in pursuance of the Sovereign Mandate of the General Body Resolution dated January 4, 2026 (**Enclosed as Annexure-A and Annexure-B**).

Dear Sir,

We, the undersigned who are the life and ordinary members of the Century Club, acting in good faith and in our capacity as the primary stakeholders, and voting electorate of the Club being a Society under the Karnataka Societies Registration Act 1960, hereby submit this formal requisition to convene a Special General Meeting (SGM) of the General Body.

This statutory requisition is a direct enforcement of an existing sovereign mandate of the Club and in pursuance to the decision taken by the members at the SGM dated 4th January 2026 which has been duly minuted, necessitated by critical administrative developments that directly impact the financial assets, structural transparency, and long-term legacy of our institution:

1. Immediate Dispatch of the Completed Audit Report

We place on record our definite knowledge that the General Body-appointed Special Audit Committee (SAC) officially concluded its auditing and delivered its finalized Final Audit Report to the Club Administration on **May 9, 2026**.

Under the express terms directed by the Chairman of the SGM on January 4, 2026, it is a mandatory requirement that this report be shared with the membership at large immediately. We request the Administration to fully comply with the January 4th mandate by circulating complete, unredacted physical and digital copies of the final SAC report to all members of the club along with the official notice for this SGM as the contents of the report and its ramifications, if any, on the functioning of the Club is critically important for members to be aware of.

2. The Verbatim Reporting Mandate: Dictated by the President

To avoid any administrative misconstruction regarding the line of reporting, we explicitly highlight that the President and Chairman of the SGM ruled on the floor of the house that the SAC answers exclusively to the General Body. As recorded on **Page 65 of the Official Verbatim Minutes (Attached as Annexure-B)**:

Mr. Aashish Amarlall (SA50): *"Sir, do the resolution sir. They have to report to the SGM, report to the General Body."*

President, Mr. C. N. Guruprasanna: *"No, no, no, the body is formed with the SGM. They will report to SGM, sir. Okay."*

Furthermore, the President explicitly directed on **Page 64 of the Minutes** that an SGM must be convened immediately upon the completion of the report:

President, Mr. C. N. Guruprasanna: *"So, immediately after the report, we have to hold SGM, or whenever SGM is called... Following to the SGM members called as early as possible. That's what I said."*

3. The Absolute Freeze on Capital Projects: The Verbatim Stop Order

We explicitly remind the current administration and any incoming Executive Committee that the capital projects of the Century Club remain under a strict, unyielding statutory freeze. The President himself explicitly deleted the provision that would have allowed ongoing works to proceed, introducing a clear amendment on **Page 64 of the Verbatim Minutes**:

President, Mr. C. N. Guruprasanna: *"Ongoing projects can go on as per the sanctioned budget. This, no, no, please, please. We, no, we will not do this. we will delete this line. We will delete this. Ongoing projects will not go as per sanction plan till the report comes. That's the amendment we have to put. So, is it very clear? Ongoing projects will not be taken up as sanctioned budgets till the enquiry committee's report has come completed."*

As a matter of corporate and society governance, the above decision taken at the SGM held on the 4th January 2026 has resulted in a restriction placed in the sense that neither the current administration nor any incoming Executive Committee possesses the lawful authority to proceed with, fund, or execute these capital projects until this pending SAC report has been formally presented to, discussed by, and decided upon by the General Body on the floor of an SGM. It is therefore imperative to place this report before the members, call for the SGM to discuss the same and take suitable corrective measures to ensure that the projects are not kept in suspended animation.

4. Rationale: Protection of Assets and Institutional Integrity

This requisition is submitted solely to ensure that the substantial financial assets of the members are fully protected, club funds are managed with total structural transparency, and the institutional legacy of the Century Club is maintained at the highest standard of integrity. Resolving the pending audit findings before major capital expenditures are undertaken or before successive administrative terms proceed is a requirement of fair governance and natural justice.

THE MANDATED AGENDA FOR THE REQUISITIONED SGM:




The business to be transacted at this requisitioned meeting shall be restricted strictly to the following verbatim agenda:

1. *To formally present, discuss, and deliberate upon the findings, conclusions, and structural recommendations contained within the Final Audit Report submitted by the Special Audit Committee (SAC) on May 9, 2026.*
2. *To review the status of all pending capital projects currently under the General Body's Stop Order; and to deliberate and take necessary administrative, financial, and corrective decisions under the club bylaws based on the findings and recommendations of the SAC report.*













Looking forward to your prompt action in this regard in the larger interest of the Club and its members.














2. Any other finding along with its recommendation.



It is also further resolved that the SAC shall comprise of minimum 7 members as nominated by the General Body.




